The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant lodged a claim that his employment, which commenced in 2004, ended by reason of redundancy on 30 June 2010. His gross weekly pay was claimed to have been €1,800.00.

Due to the non-attendance of the appellant at the 23 August 2012 hearing assigned to him, the Tribunal did not require any testimony from anyone present on behalf of the respondent.

**Determination:**

Due to the non-attendance of the appellant at the Tribunal hearing (for which he was sent hearing notification to the only address that the Tribunal had for him) the Tribunal finds that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, falls for want of prosecution.
