The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

There was no appearance by or representation on behalf of the respondent. The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was on notice of the hearing. The claimant gave evidence that he applied to the company for a redundancy payment but did not receive it.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that a redundancy situation occurred and that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following information:

Date of Termination: 8 October 2010
Weekly Gross Pay: €578.00
