The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed to the Tribunal at the Tribunal hearing that his employment, which commenced on 1 May 2007, ended by reason of redundancy on 4 July 2011. His gross weekly pay was claimed to have been €559.71.

A hearing notice was sent to the respondent (which had disputed the appellant's commencement date in writing) but no evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the Tribunal hearing to disprove the appellant's testimony.

**Determination:**

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds (on the appellant's

uncontested testimony at the Tribunal hearing) that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 14 January 1971  
Date of commencement: 01 May 2007  
Date of termination: 04 July 2011  
Gross weekly pay: €559.71

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
