The determination of the Tribunal is as follows:

Determination

The representative of the claimant told the Tribunal that he had represented the claimant and 9 of his former colleagues. Following a hearing that the claimant did not attend the claims of his 9 former colleagues were determined. The claimant's claims were adjourned to give him the opportunity to appear before the Tribunal and give evidence relating to the termination of his employment with the respondent.

The representative of the claimant, despite extensive efforts, had been unable to make contact with the claimant. He believes that the claimant is now resident outside the state and has no reason to think that he will return.

The Tribunal strikes out the claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007, the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 and the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997 for want of prosecution.
