The Tribunal is satisfied that *appellant B* and the respondent were properly notified of this hearing. Neither *appellant B* or the respondent nor representatives on their behalf appeared for this hearing.

Having heard the uncontested submission of *appellant A* the Tribunal allows his appeals under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 and awards the appellant €576.92 under each of those Acts, such sums being respectively the equivalent of one week's pay in lieu of notice and compensation for five days' holidays due to him.
