The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The appellant told the Tribunal that she undertook work for the respondent which was a bridal shop and she made all the dresses. One Friday evening she was told that there was no more work for her. She discussed redundancy with her employer who told her that she could not pay her redundancy. She was paid on a weekly basis and she did not always receive her pay on time.

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal allows the appeal and awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:-

Date of birth: 23 December 1949
Date employment began
Date employment ended 26th March 2011

Gross weekly pay €450.00.
