The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

This case came to the Tribunal as an employer appeal against Rights Commissioner Decision r-072162-pw-08/DI under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991, by which the employee (ES) was awarded the sum of €1,896.70 (net of statutory deductions, assumed to be the standard rate of income tax).

No-one attended the hearing from or on behalf of the appellant company.

Determination:

The Tribunal satisfied itself that the hearing notification to the appellant company was in order. Given that no-one attended the hearing from or on behalf of the appellant company, the Tribunal dismisses the appeal and affirms Rights Commissioner Decision r-072162-pw-08/DI under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991, by which the employee (ES) was awarded the sum of €1,896.70 (net of statutory deductions, assumed to be the standard rate of income tax).
