There was no appearance for or on behalf of the respondent. The Tribunal are satisfied that proper notification was sent to the respondent. Having heard the uncontested evidence of the appellant the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and the appellant is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts and based on the following information:

Date of Commencement: 10<sup>th</sup> May 2004  
Date of Notice: 27<sup>th</sup> September 2010  
Date of Termination: 27<sup>th</sup> September 2010  
Gross Weekly Wage: €440.00

The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 also succeeds and the appellant is awarded €1,170.00, this being four weeks gross pay as compensation in lieu of notice.

These awards are made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
