The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

This appeal was not contested by the respondent. Having heard the circumstances of this case the Tribunal finds that the appellant's employment with the respondent was terminated by way of redundancy. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and the appellant is awarded a lump sum under those Acts, and based on the following:

Date of Birth: 23 March 1973
Date of Commencement: 24 February 1992
Date of Termination: 18 March 2011
Gross Weekly Wage: €484.83

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
