Having heard the uncontested evidence of the claimants in this case the Tribunal determined that compensation to be the most appropriate remedy and accordingly the Tribunal awards the sum of

€1,500.00 under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 to each of the above named claimants.
