## The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence the Tribunal finds that the European Communities (Protection of Employees on Transfer of Undertaking) Regulations 2003 apply to the appellant's continuous employment since the 8<sup>th</sup> of January 1996. His employment terminated by reason of redundancy on the 15<sup>th</sup> April 2011 and he is entitled to a redundancy payment calculated on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:18 February 1962Date of Commencement:8 January 1996Date of Termination:15 April 2011Gross Weekly Pay:€800.00

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.
