The respondent having conceded liability in this regard, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth:	7 June 1975
Date of commencement of employment:	3 May 2005
Date of termination of employment:	9 February 2011
Gross weekly pay:	€320.98

The Tribunal is satisfied that the claimant was served with an RP 9 form on 8 February 2011 which placed him on temporary lay- off. The claimant gave evidence to the Tribunal that he refused to sign the RP 9 form. The Tribunal is satisfied that had he complied with the

requirements of the RP 9 form he would not have been entitled to minimum notice. Accordingly the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005 fails.
