This case came before the Tribunal by way of an employee seeking to implement a recommendation of a Rights Commissioner under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007, ref: r-096514-ud-10/MMG.

The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

There was no appearance by or representation on behalf of the respondent. The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was on notice of the hearing.

The Tribunal, is satisfied that the recommendation of the Rights Commissioner has not been carried out by the employer/respondent in accordance with its terms or at all and it is further satisfied that the prescribed six-week time limit for bringing an appeal against the recommendation has expired and no such appeal has been brought. Accordingly, the Tribunal

makes a determination to like effect as the Rights Commissioner's recommendation that the respondent pays the claimant €3,750.00 (three thousand seven hundred and fifty euro) under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007.
