The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. Having heard the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal find that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and the appellant is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 25 January 1966
Date of Commencement: 06 April 1997
Date of Termination: 17 September 2010
Gross Weekly Wage: €1000.00
