Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:25 December 1954Date of commencement:12 March 2007Date of termination:14 January 2011Gross weekly pay:€350.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Allowing the claim lodged under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €700.00 (this amount being equivalent to two weeks' gross pay at €350.00 per week).

In addition, the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €700.00 (this amount being equivalent to two weeks' holidays) under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, in respect of holidays outstanding at the time of termination of her employment with the respondent.
