### **Determination:**

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on his behalf appeared at the hearing.

### Appellant No. 1

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:7th October 1985Date of Commencement:4th April 2005Date of Termination:2nd July 2010Gross Weekly Wage:€838.11

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in employment which is insurable for all purposes under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act 2005.

# Appellant No. 2

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: $2^{nd}$  October 1986Date of Commencement $16^{th}$  January 2006Date of Termination: $2^{nd}$  July 2010Gross Weekly Wage:€647.01

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
