The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant's employment, which commenced on 2 September 2002, ended by reason of redundancy on 2 April 2010. His gross weekly pay was €838.11.

A hearing notice was sent to the respondent but no evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 09 June 1949

Date of commencement: 02 September 2002

Date of termination: 02 April 2010
Gross weekly pay: €838.11

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
