The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

This case came before the Tribunal by way of an appeal by the appellants against the decisions of the Rights Commissioner ref: r-093131-pw-10/MMG, r-093040-pw-10/MMG.

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing on 13th November 2012.

The Tribunal heard evidence from the appellants that they were placed on a period of lay off due to a shortage of work at the beginning of 2009. They were subsequently made redundant, at which time they received their statutory redundancy entitlements. The appellants were seeking payment of wages for the period of lay off. The appellants confirmed that while they were laid off from the respondent company they were in receipt of social welfare benefits.

Determination

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellants the Tribunal dismiss the appeal under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991 and upholds the decisions of the Rights Commissioner ref: r-093131-pw-10/MMG and r-093040-pw-10/MMG.
