The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

This case came before the Tribunal as a result of an appeal by the employer (the appellant) against a decision of the Rights Commissioner under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991 ref. r-0927517-pw-10/TB.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative appeared on his behalf at the hearing.

Having heard evidence from the appellant (the employer) in this case the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant did not comply with the mandatory statutory requirements for the making of a valid appeal to the Tribunal pursuant to the provisions of Section 7(2) (b) of the Payment of Wages, Act, 1991.
