The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that her employment, which commenced on 1 August 2005, ended by reason of redundancy on 29 October 2010. Her gross weekly pay was €435.00.

A hearing notice was sent to the respondent but no evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 07 September 1979
Date of commencement: 01 August 2005
Date of termination: 29 October 2010
Gross weekly pay: €435.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
