The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

### Determination:

#### Appellant No. 1

The Tribunal is satisfied that appellant no. 1 was duly notified of the hearing. Neither appellant no. 1 nor a representative on her behalf appeared at this hearing.

Accordingly, the Tribunal dismisses her claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 for want of prosecution.

## **Appellant No. 2**

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation applied in this case but as the company had ceased trading they were unable to pay this appellant her redundancy entitlement.

The Tribunal finds that appellant no. 2 is entitled to a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	18 <sup>th</sup> April 1973
Date of Commencement:	28 <sup>th</sup> May 2007
Date of Termination:	15 <sup>th</sup> October 2010
Gross Weekly Wage:	€180.00

This award is subject to the appellant having been in employment, which is insurable for all purposes under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act 2005.
