Appellant 1

The Tribunal after carefully considering all the evidence is satisfied that a genuine redundancy situation existed. Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that *appellant 1* is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Employment commenced	03 rd March 2001
Employment ended	06 th August 2011
Gross weekly pay	€180.00

Appellant 2

The Tribunal after carefully considering all the evidence is satisfied that a genuine redundancy situation existed. Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that *appellant 2* is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Gross weekly pay	€138.40
