Claimant 1 commenced employment on the 15 March 2010 and his employment ended on the 13 August 2010 without receiving any notice. He took no holidays during the period of

employment

Claimant 2 commenced employment on the 15 March 2010 and his employment ended on the 5 August 2010 without receiving any notice. He took no holidays during the period of employment.

Claimant 3 commenced employment on the 8 March 2010 and his employment ended on the 20 August 2010 without any notice. He took two days holidays during the period of employment.

Claimant 4 commenced employment on the 17 March 2010 and his employment ended on the 20 August 2010 without any notice. He took no holidays during the period of employment.

Claimant 5 commenced employment on the 15 March 2010 and his employment ended on the 27 August 2010 without any notice. He took no holidays during the period of employment.

In the absence of any evidence from the respondent to dispute the claimants' evidence the Tribunal awards each and every one of the claimants €650.52 in lieu of one week's notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employments Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal awards each and every one of the claimants €940.83, this being ten days' pay for arrears of holiday pay under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
