This case came before the Tribunal as an appeal by an employee of the decision of the Rights Commissioner reference number r-091662-ud-10/JT.

Determination

The appellant was on notice of the hearing but was not in attendance. His representative made an application to have the hearing adjourned. The respondent had come prepared to contest the appeal and did not favour an adjournment.
