Determination

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. Having heard the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal find that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and the appellant is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	18 January 1978
Date of Commencement:	05 May 2008
Date of Termination:	10 September 2010
Gross Weekly Wage:	€150.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment in accordance with the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The appellant is awarded €300.00 being the equivalent to 2 weeks pay in lieu of notice under the

Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
