The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The claimant told the Tribunal that he commenced employment on the 1st November 1984 with the respondent. He worked as a foreman and he was let go on the 7th August 2006. He stated that he never left his job.

On the uncontroverted evidence of the claimant the Tribunal finds that his employment ended without notice and he is entitled to eight weeks gross pay in lieu of notice in the amount of €10,400 (€1,300.00 per week) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

There is a weekly ceiling of €600.00 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
