The appellant claimed that her employment, which commenced on 9 February 2009, ended by reason of redundancy on 25 July 2011. Her average gross weekly pay over the course of her employment was assessed at €360.00.

No evidence was offered on behalf of the respondent at the hearing to dispute the appellant's entitlement to receive a redundancy lump sum.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
