Determination

The Tribunal heard evidence from the appellant regarding her employment history. The Tribunal is satisfied after hearing this evidence that the appellant has not accumulated 104 weeks continuous service with the respondent as required by section 7(5) of the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 in order to bring a claim for redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal dismisses the claim.

The Tribunal heard further evidence from the appellant that she received her notice entitlement and therefore the Tribunal finds that the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005 fails and is hereby dismissed.
