## Determination

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Commencement:	17 September 2007
Date of Termination:	11 May 2012
Gross Pay:	€606.29

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in employment which is insurable for all purposes under the relevant Social Welfare Acts.

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of  $\notin 600.00$  applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

The Tribunal awards the appellant €1212.58, being the equivalent to two weeks pay, in respect of his statutory notice entitlement under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
