Determination:

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent. The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing.

The appellant worked as a bookkeeper for the respondent. She gave evidence that the respondent was now homeless and living rough on the streets in Carlow.

The appellant's employment came to an end due to no more work being available for her. The business is now closed.

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence the Tribunal finds that she is entitled to a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payment Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:
