Determination

The respondent conceded that the appellant's employment was terminated by way of redundancy. The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 calculated on the basis of the following criteria:

Date of Commencement: 13 April 2007
Date of Termination: 05 August 2011
Gross Weekly Pay: €630.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. A statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
