The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing on 28th February 2013. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant presented at the hearing, the Tribunal finds that the appellant's employment was terminated by reason of redundancy.

Accordingly, the Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:
