The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 14 August 2006, ended by reason of redundancy on 24 August 2011. His gross weekly pay was €400.00. There were no breaks in his service.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing to contest the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:
