There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent and the Tribunal is satisfied that she was properly notified of the hearing.

Appellant's case

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on 26th April 2004 and was let go, without notice or payment in lieu thereof, when the business closed down on 18 th August 2011. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €600.00 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

Determination

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him €2,400.00 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and alump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based onthe following criteria.

Commencement Date	26 th April 2004
Date notice received	N/A
Termination date	18 th August 2011
Gross pay	€600.00 per week

This award is made subject to the claimant having been in insurable employment, during the relevant period, in accordance with the Social Welfare Acts.

It should be noted that any payment made through the Social Insurance Fund is based on maximum earnings of ϵ 600.00 per week.
