Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the liquidator was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the liquidator nor a representative on his behalf appeared at the hearing.

The Tribunal is satisfied that the claimant has sufficient continuity of service to bring her claim within the provisions of the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007. On the uncontested evidence of the claimant, the Tribunal is satisfied that she was unfairly dismissed and awards her the sum of €1,500 under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007.

The Tribunal awards the claimant €212.30 being the equivalent of one week's pay under

the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and also awards the claimant €445.83 under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.

These awards are made subject to the appellant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.
