The Tribunal, being satisfied that the respondents were properly on notice of the hearing, finds,

based on the uncontroverted evidence, that the appellants were dismissed by reason of redundancy by the second named respondent and are entitled to lump sum payments under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria

The first named appellant is awarded €600-00, the second named appellant is awarded €572-00, being one week's pay in each case, under the Minimum Notice And Terms of Employment Acts,1973 to 2005.

These awards are made subject to the appellants having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act, 2005 during the relevant period.

The Tribunal had no jurisdiction to deal with the claim of the first named appellant under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 as the claim related to overtime arrangements whereas the Tribunal's jurisdiction is restricted to Part III of the Act which deals with Holidays.
