The Tribunal is satisfied that the liquidator was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the liquidator nor a representative on his behalf appeared at the hearing.

Based on the claimant's uncontested evidence, the Tribunal awards the claimant €212.30 being the equivalent of one week's pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005. The Tribunal also awards the claimant €445.83 under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
