Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of this hearing. The appellant commenced work in July 2006 and worked continuously full-time until she was put on 3-day week in May 2010. She continued to work a 3-day week until she was informed that her position was being made redundant as of the 15th of May 2011 as the business was closing. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria;

Date of Commencement:	19th July 2006
Date of Termination:	15 May 2011
Gross Weekly Pay:	€224.49
