The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

This case came before the Tribunal where the claimant was seeking implementation of the recommendation of the Rights Commissioner under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1997 to 2007, reference r-123263-ud-1/JT.

The claimant attended the hearing and confirmed that the recommendation of the Rights commissioner was not implemented. The respondent indicated that the company was under the impression that today's hearing was an appeal hearing.
