Respondent: No appearance or representation on behalf of the respondent.

#### Background:

The receiver for a second-named respondent was represented at the hearing. The Tribunal was informed that the second-named respondent was not the claimant's employer. There was no appearance on behalf of a third-named respondent.

Representation for the claimants informed the Tribunal that there was a difficulty in ascertaining the identity of the employer due to variance in the employer named on various documentation received by the claimants. However, the employer number utilised for tax purposes correlated to the respondent company.

#### **Determination:**

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was the claimants' employer. The other named respondents were released from the proceedings. Based on the claimants' uncontested evidence the Tribunal find that he is entitled to the sum of €423.08 (being the equivalent of one week's gross pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
