Date employment ceased	17 th October 2008
Gross weekly pay	€800.00

There is a weekly ceiling of €600.00 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
