The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The company secretary advised the Tribunal that the case was not being contested. Accordingly, from the uncontested evidence provided by the claimant the claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007 succeeds.

Compensation is the most appropriate remedy in this case. The Tribunal awards the claimant the sum of €200,000.00, in compensation under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007. This sum represents 104 weeks' pay at €1923.08 per week.

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the claimant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.
