There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent and the Tribunal is satisfied that she was properly notified of the hearing.

Appellant's case

The appellant stated that she commenced employment with the respondent on 5th September 2006 and was let go when the business closed down on 18th December 2010. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €184.60 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

Determination

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal is satisfied that her employment was terminated by way of redundancy and it awards her a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:
