Summary:

The Tribunal was satisfied that the respondent was notified of the hearing. The Tribunal was in receipt of a T2 form from the respondent setting out her position.

The appellant informed the Tribunal that her employment had terminated by reason of redundancy. The appellant had received a redundancy payment based on the last four years of her employment. The appellant submitted that she was due a further redundancy payment as her employment had transferred to the respondent in 2007. The appellant did not receive a redundancy payment from her original employer at that time. Following the transfer the venue and nature of the appellant's work remained unchanged.

Determination:

Based on the appellant's uncontested evidence the Tribunal is satisfied that there was a transfer of the appellant's employment to the respondent. Accordingly, the appellant's redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, should be based on the followingcriteria:

Date of Birth:	16 July 1965
Date of Commencement:	1 March 2001
Date of Termination:	13 August 2011
Gross Weekly Pay:	€330.00

Please note: the appellant has already received the sum of $\in 3,273.60$ by way of a redundancy payment.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
