The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

This case came before the Tribunal as an appeal by an employer (appellant) against the decision of the Rights Commissioner under the Payment of Wages Act 1991 reference number r-117788-pw-11/EH.

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was notified of the hearing. As the appellant did not appear the appeal is struck out. The decision of the Rights Commissioner awarding the respondent €151.37 under the Payment of Wages Act 1991 is upheld.

The respondent made an application for his costs. The Tribunal finds that the appeal is frivolous and vexatious and awards the respondent the sum of €50.00 in costs under S.19 (2) of S.I. No 24/1968.
